# Circular 17 OF ASA 2017 (02/13) – REGISTERED TRACK; COURSE AND ROUTE MEASURERS

In accordance with IAAF and ASA Rules and Regulations, all tracks, routes and courses of events listed on the ASA National/Provincial Fixtures lists needs to be certified by qualified Track; Course and Route Measurers.

Only performances on certified tracks, routes and courses will be acknowledged by the IAAF and ASA for the purpose of recognizing records, selection of teams, qualifying for national/international events, etc.

Certificates of all tracks, routes and courses should be in the possession of the ASA Province in which the event takes place.

It is also important that each Event/Race Organizer of events listed on the ASA National or Provincial Fixtures list, should be in possession of such Track; Course and Route Certificate.

It is the duty of the Event/Race Referee to confirm the eligibility of such Track; Course and Route Certificate before the event/race can start.

To standardize the process of certifying tracks, routes and courses of events listed on the ASA National/Provincial Fixtures list, ASA kindly request ASA provinces to submit the names of all delegates who is active in providing any track, route and course Measuring/certificate in your province.

ASA will compile a list of track, route and course Measurers/certifiers and place it on the ASA Website.

As from 2018, all track, route and course Measurers/certifiers will have to register on an annual basis, and only track, route and course Measurers/certifiers listed on the ASA website will be allowed to certify tracks, routes or courses in South Africa.

ASA Provinces are requested to submit the list of track, route and course Measurers/certifiers delegates used in provinces to ASA before or on 28 February 2017.

Please use the format as indicated below to register the track, route and course Measurers/certifiers with ASA.
