### Circular 3 of ASA 2017 (01/16) – ASA RELAY SQUAD

At the ASA QGM in October 2016, Mr Aleck Skhosana, after been re-elected as President of ASA, stated that ASA are now ranked among the top 5 in the world after its success at the 2016 Olympic Games. He indicated that to improve on this position at the 2020 Olympic Games - ASA will be required to work in a 4 year cycle rather than a 1-year cycle as practiced in the past. He also stated that in the next 4 year cycle ASA will focus on preparing Relay teams.

With reference to the above, ASA now announce its 1<sup>st</sup> Relay Squad in preparation for the 2017 World Championships leading to the 2020 Olympic Games.

The progress of the Relay squad will be given competition opportunities during the ASA 1 hour Elite Comp + Qualifier IAAF World Relays and hold two local training camps. The 1<sup>st</sup> milestone in the progress of the squad will be the 2017 World Relays challenge in April 2017

The next milestone for the listed athletes will be the 2017 IAAF World Senior Championships.

Athletes without an ASA Permanent License cannot appeal.**
