Circular 145 of ASA 2017 (11/15) – ALL SYSTEMS GO FOR 2017 ASA NATIONAL TECHNICAL SYMPOSIUM

It is all systems go for the 1st National Technical Symposium held in South Africa for more than a decade.

The 2017 ASA National Technical Officials Symposium will take place from 18-19 November 2017 at the University of Pretoria, Tshwane.

More than 130 of South Africa’s top Referees, Course Measurers and Assizers have already entered for the 2017 ASA National Technical Officials Symposium.

The theme of the 2017 ASA National Technical Officials Symposium will be “Quality Control”.

To demonstrate the seriousness of ASA to increase the quality of Officiating in South Africa, all attendees will be required to do a practical and theoretical evaluation during the first three hours of the 2017 ASA National Technical Officials Symposium.

The primary function of the evaluations are to establish if Technical Officials can differentiate between the duties of a Technical Official and the duties of a Referee, Assizer or Course Measurer, otherwise called as Quality Controllers.

After the evaluation, ASA will start briefing the Quality Controllers on the latest Rules and Regulations of the IAAF Competition Rules as well as the latest changes in the 2018 ASA Rules and Regulations.

At the end of the 2017 ASA National Technical Officials Symposium, and after the results of the evaluations are made public, the Technical Officials, if successful, will be issued with a Quality Control Identification Card to identify the Officials with a mandate to officiate at ASA National events.
